

Contractor held for child labour

Seven children rescued from worksite near Settihalli Railway Station

A Bengaluru-based railway contractor and his associates have been booked, and seven child labourers rescued near Settihalli Railway Station by the Labour department and organisations working for rights of children on Saturday. An FIR has been filed against them at the Government Railway Police station at Krantivira Sangolli Rayanna railway station.

The contractor, Govindaraj Nagamuni (47) of Sachin Construction based in Nelamangala, is the prime accused, while his associates Durgaiyah (40) from Ramanapete village in Telangana and Venkatesh Gujjalu (26) from Gurugundla Village in Andhra Pradesh have been named in the FIR. The children from Telangana had accompanied their parents to work on the project between Ram-

anagara and Yeliyur.

DG Sumathi, State Co-ordinator, Bachpan Bachao Andolan, who got a tipoff on child labour, said, "We found three girls and four boys working along with their parents. They were all below 18 years old. The youngest is 12 years and 6 months

and the oldest 17 years and six months. It is not a case of trafficking as parents were also working with their children."

"The nature of their job was hazardous and risky. They were placing crushed stones on the railway tracks and levelling them," she said. The Aadhaar cards of children seemed fake as the addresses did not have pincodes and had other details missing, she added. The contractor has agreed to pay a penalty of Rs 1.4 lakh, at Rs 20,000 per child. The Labour Department will also pay Rs 15,000 for a child. "The money will be deposited as an FD in the child's name and will be handed over after they turn 18 years old," Sumathi said. The court may also impose fines on the contractor.

Vidyarayana Open Shelter for Children played a role in the rescue.

CRIME PATROL

Two arrested for assault on towing vehicle staff

BENGALURU: The Yelahanka New Town police have arrested two men for allegedly assaulting staff of a towing vehicle. Police said Vijay and Rajashekhar had allegedly assaulted three staffers of the towing vehicle attached to the Yelahanka traffic police station, on July 28. Lakshman Gowda, Anand, and Kiran were injured in the incident. The staff had seized a two-wheeler from a no-parking zone near Yelahanka New Town bus stop. Meanwhile, Rajashekhar, the owner of the two-wheeler, along with Vijay and another, climbed onto the towing vehicle and attacked the staff with helmets, before taking away the vehicle. The police arrested the duo on Saturday, but are yet to nab the third suspect.

City police book 14 rowdies under NDPS, Arms Acts

A day after the South-East division police detained 18 rowdy-sheeters, as many as 14 of them were booked under the Arms Act and NDPS Act on Sunday, after the police recovered lethal weapons (swords, machetes and daggers) from their houses. A senior police officer said that some of them were caught under the influence of drugs during the raids, and were taken for medical tests.

According to the police, FIRs have been registered against seven rowdies under the NDPS and Arms Acts, and medical reports of around 33

rowdies are awaited. Seven others were booked on charges of possessing weapons to hatch plots of robbery and murder. Further action will be taken based on reports.

The police suspect that those rowdies who have been booked under the NDPS Act are linked to drug rackets, while others are involved in anti-social activities. Several habitual offenders managed to give cops a slip during the surprise checks, and efforts are on to track them.

It may be recalled that in the wee hours of Saturday, a team headed by DCP Srinath Mahadev Joshi raided the houses of 63 rowdies.

Short circuit causes fire in bank

A minor fire broke out at a bank in City Market police station limits on Sunday evening. No casualty was reported in the mishap, which is suspected to have occurred due to an electric short circuit. Police said the incident occurred in the City Market branch of the Bank of Baroda. The Fire & Emergency Services Department was pressed into service and they doused the fire.
